Who is Pitch In For Baseball & Softball?

Founded in 2005, Pitch In For Baseball & Softball (PIFBS) is a Philadelphia area nonprofit organization committed to improving children's lives in the U.S. and abroad by increasing access to baseball and softball. By removing equipment as a barrier to play and supporting high quality programs, PIFBS helps contribute to positive youth development and gives the gift of play. Over the years, PIFBS has donated more than \$10 million in baseball/softball gear to help over 900,000 kids play ball in every state in the U.S. and 100+ countries around the world.

PIFBS has four core programs:

- <u>Domestic and International Equipment Grants</u> Leagues, schools, and organizations complete an application to receive equipment. In 2019, PIFBS completed over 600 projects in 43 states, 1 U.S. territory, and 25 countries helping more than 100,000 kids play ball.
- <u>School Based Program</u> Due to budget limitations/deficits many schools have been forced to eliminate nonacademic after-school programs. PIFBS works with schools to help stretch limited budgets and continue/start/expand their baseball and softball programs.

2019 School Based Program Partnership:

- Our School Based Program started in our backyard within the Philadelphia School District. In 2019, PIFBS helped 64 teams get much needed equipment and 79% of participating students increased their attendance at school as a result of playing ball!
- In 2019, PIFBS had School Based Programs in Philadelphia, Minneapolis/St. Paul (supported by the Twins), Bronx (supported by the Yankees), northern Kentucky (supported by the Reds), and Chicago (supported by Wilson Sporting Goods).
- <u>Disaster Relief Program</u> In times of tragedy, children are the most affected. Baseball and softball can help to restore a sense of normalcy amidst the chaos. PIFBS has helped to rebuild entire leagues and helped thousands of kids to start their seasons on time. PIFBS has assisted with relief efforts in NY/NJ shoreline following Hurricane Sandy; Joplin, MO; the Gulf Coast region; Japan, and Houston, TX following major flooding in 2016. In 2018, PIFBS completed its largest single project in history in the form of a disaster relief project in Puerto Rico.
- <u>Kids Helping Kids: Youth Philanthropy</u> About 60% of the equipment PIFBS has available for equipment grants comes from the efforts of motivated, caring kids who run collections and fundraisers on PIFBS' behalf.

Since 2005, PIFBS has helped hundreds of thousands of boys and girls worldwide play baseball and softball. And none of it would have been possible without the support of thousands of kids, families, companies, and community partners who have generously donated their time, equipment, and dollars to PIFBS. Our PIFBS Day at the Phillies' brings our fans, supporters, and kids who have benefitted from our programs. Funds raised will help to provide baseball and softball equipment for teams, leagues, and communities in the Philadelphia area and across the country that cannot afford/access the proper gear to play ball.
