A WORD FROM THE CEO

Dear Friends,

On the most basic level, baseball/softball is a game that is played in backyards, parks, playgrounds, sandlots, and streets. In addition to its pure play element, the game is also a powerful vehicle for youth development that teaches important life lessons like teamwork, discipline, and overcoming adversity. It helps build confidence, offers a constructive alternative for after-school hours, and gives kids positive adult role models in their coaches. It is a game that brings communities together—unifying people from different backgrounds, religions, ethnic groups, and socioeconomics as well as offering parents a way to connect with their kids.

As I think about 2023, one word comes to mind - **IMPACT/im,pak(t): to have a strong effect on someone or something.**

This word is a constant in the Pitch In For Baseball & Softball world. It anchors us and our work. It drives us. It connects us to donors, supporters, partners, and the kids we help. It is why we exist—to positively impact children through this amazing game of baseball/softball, to give them the gift of play. In 2023 alone, we donated more than \$10 million in equipment grants to help 207,867 children play ball in 48 states and 24 countries, as well as USVI and Puerto Rico.

Since 2005, Pitch In For Baseball & Softball has had the honor of working with thousands of volunteers, fans, coaches, donors, and partners to get equipment into the hands of kids and communities that need it most. Together, we have helped more than 1.7 million children play ball and have delivered equipment to more than 117 different countries around the world.

Pitch In For Baseball & Softball has been able to have an impact because of our donors. I want to share three special examples that embody the impact that we are able to have because of you.



Justin, Chicago Heat – Chicago, IL

Justin (9 years old) started playing baseball when he was six. Earlier this year, Justin was diagnosed with hypertrophic cardiomyopathy, a rare heart disease and was told by his doctors that he could never play baseball again. Soon after the devastating news, the Chicago Heat received an equipment grant from PIFBS. Justin was so excited to help deliver the donated gear to his team. He still wanted to remain on the team in any way possible. He was even there for all practices, despite not being able to play. Later in the season, Justin was given the green light to return to baseball activities! While returning with limitations, Justin was given the support he needed from his baseball team during this tough time in his life.



Herman J. Russell West End Academy – Atlanta, GA

With 100% of students qualifying for free/reduced lunches and less than 20% of students performing at grade level in math and reading, Herman J. Russell West End Academy is in need of resources to support student success. At the start of the 2023 season, it was discovered that all of the softball gloves were stolen. With little to no budget for the softball program, they were unable to purchase new ones. Pitch In For Baseball & Softball provided an equipment grant with the much-needed softball gloves as well as other gear which resulted in a record number of players in more than 10 years!



Fastpitch Association – Canton, OH

North Canton Fastpitch (NCFA) is a relatively new league works to keep costs as low and accessible as possible for families. NCFA provides all coaches with equipment for the team to share to make the game more accessible for families. NCFA does not own their fields and rents from the city. Rising equipment and field rental costs have made it more expensive to operate and put the season in question. The equipment grant from PIFBS allowed them not to go under. The dollars that had been earmarked for equipment allowed the league to purchase new bases for player safety and shift dollars to other areas of program areas like additional field availability and scholarships.

On behalf of the entire PIFBS team, I want to thank you for your continued support, and I hope you will stay with us in our mission to eliminate equipment as a barrier to play. It is because of you that kids like Justin and groups like North Canton Fastpitch and Herman Russell West End Academy are able to have the opportunity to play.

Thank you for making a difference in the lives of a million kids across the globe!

ABOUT US

OUR PURPOSE

Baseball and softball are a powerful vehicle for youth development teaching important life lessons like teamwork, respect, overcoming adversity, and the art of winning and losing. It helps build confidence, offers a constructive alternative for after-school hours, and gives kids positive role models in their coaches. It is a game that brings communities together - unifying people from different backgrounds, religions, ethnic groups, and socioeconomics as well as offering parents a way to connect with their kids.

Each year, more than 25 million children play baseball or softball; however, the recent Sports & Fitness Industry report shows that only 26% of participants come from families living below the federal poverty line. Additionally, less than 30% of participants are from diverse communities. This data - compacted with the growing costs associated with the game (equipment, registration fees, etc.) – tells us that the game is harder to access for under-resourced communities.

Pitch In For Baseball & Softball's mission is to eliminate barriers to play by providing equipment to support kids around the world who are most in need. We work to provide access to the game so that any child, regardless of economic background, can benefit from the lessons and opportunities that the game provides.

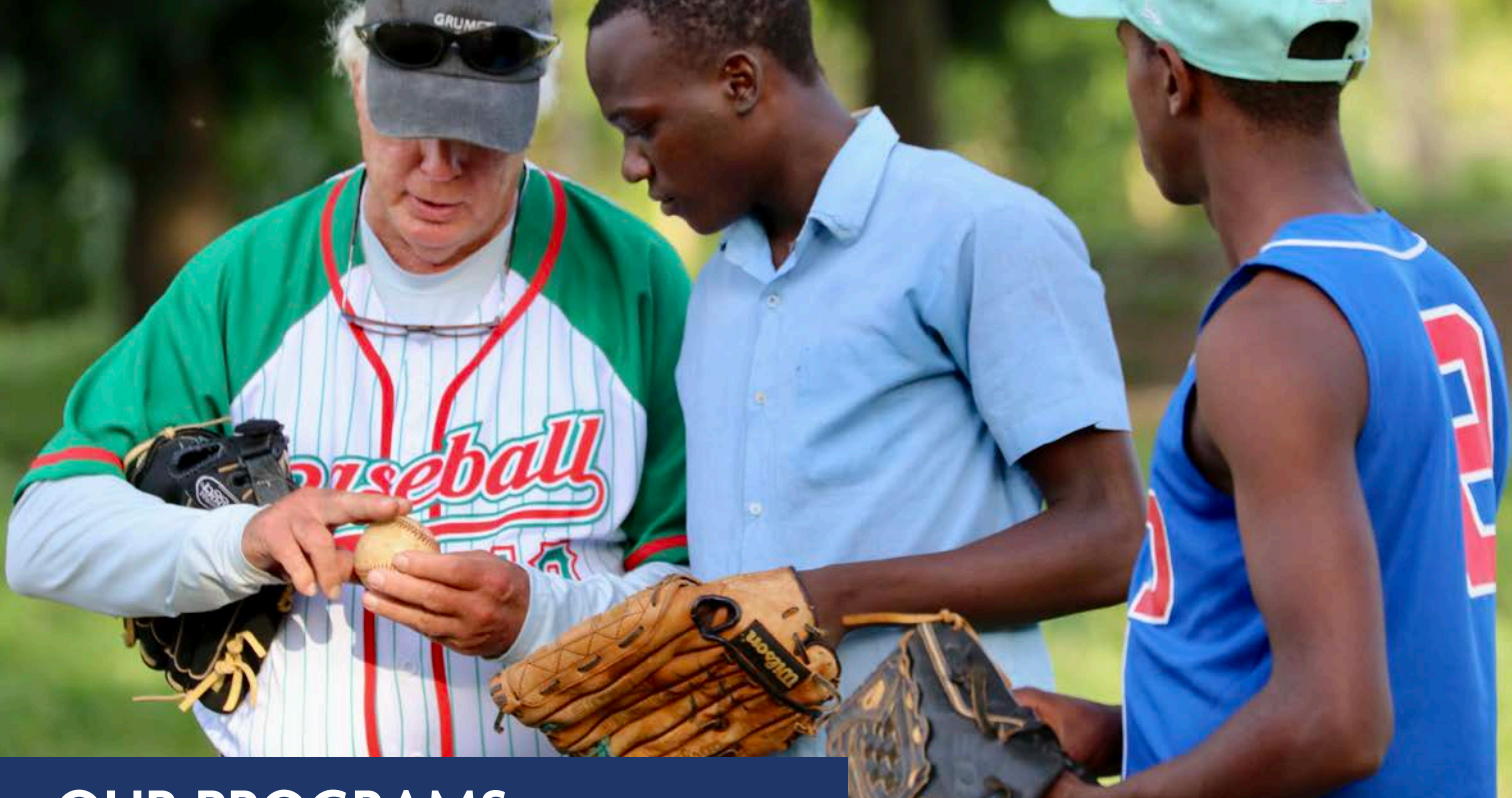
OUR REACH

Since our inception in 2005, PIFBS has helped over 1.7 million kids across every state in the U.S. and over 117 countries, completing an average of 1200 projects annually.

OUR PROGRAMS

Since 2005, PIFBS has donated more than \$30 million in equipment to help more than 1.7 million children play ball across all 50 states and over 117 different countries. PIFBS achieves the mission through four core strategies:

Domestic and International Equipment Grants – These grants are a blend of new and used equipment and designed to help leagues, teams, and community organizations around the globe receive the proper equipment to play baseball and softball.

School-Based Program – Launched in 2008, our School-Based Program helps schools/districts stretch limited budgets, reduce participation fees, and shift funds to other areas, such as transportation. PIFBS delivers formal School-Based Programs in Philadelphia, Northern Kentucky, and Minneapolis/St. Paul as well as dozens of individual schools both domestically and abroad.

Disaster Relief Program – In times of tragedy, baseball and softball can help restore a sense of normalcy for children amidst the chaos. PIFBS has helped rebuild entire leagues so that thousands of kids can start their seasons on time. PIFBS has assisted with relief efforts on the New York/New Jersey shoreline following Hurricane Sandy; Joplin, MO; the Gulf Coast region; Japan; Houston; Puerto Rico; and more.

Targeted Programs – PIFBS receives funding from partners and industry leaders to deliver programming in communities of interest. PIFBS manages all components including identifying groups in need of equipment when appropriate, program development, and measuring impact based on partners' charitable interests. Some current partners include Major League Baseball, Little League, the MLB/MLBPA Youth Development Foundation, and Wilson Sporting Goods.

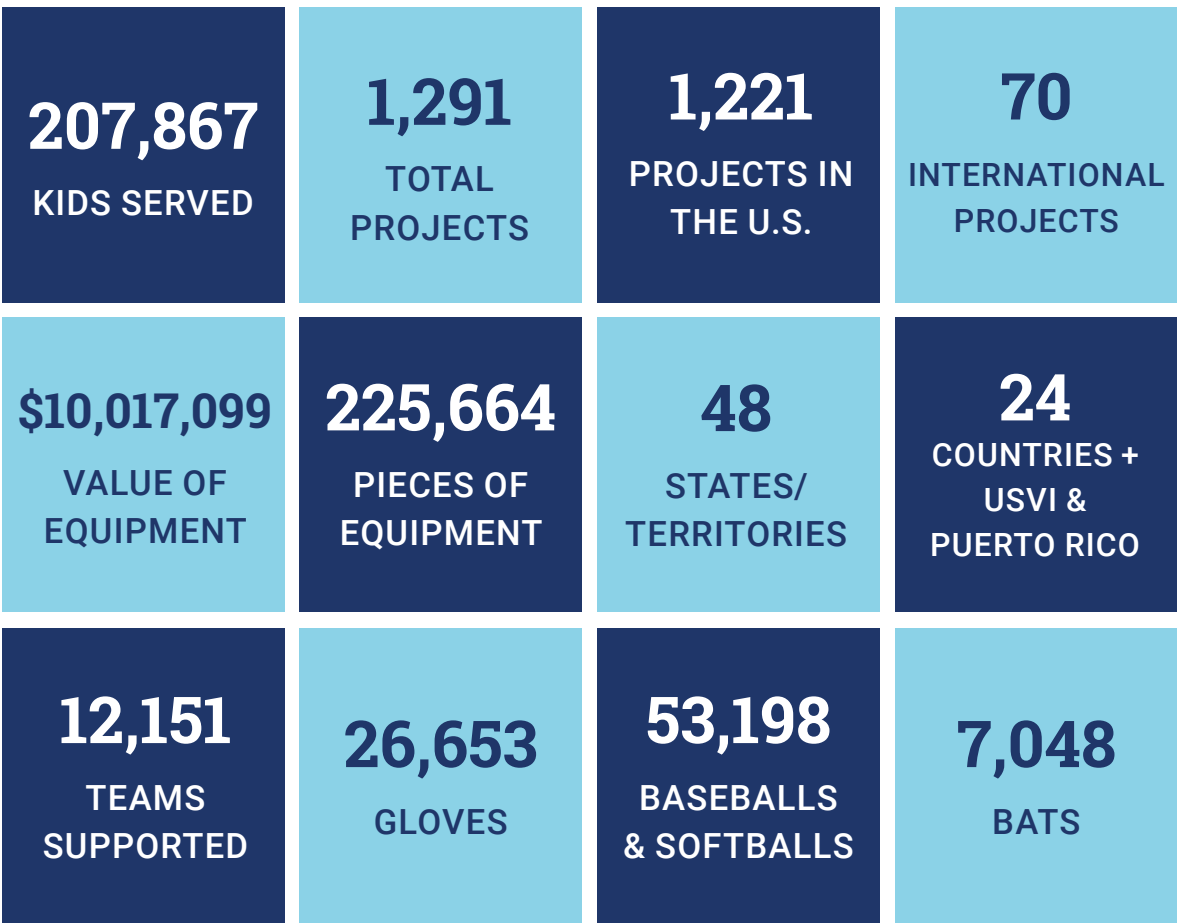
Each equipment recipient completes a report detailing the impact of the donation on the program and participants.

In addition to the programs, PIFBS also has a very active volunteer program thanks to the support of nearly 100 children who choose us as their charitable partner for youth service learning projects, whether for school service learning, Bar/Bat Mitzvahs, Eagle Scout projects, or simply supporting others play the game we love. About 60% of the equipment PIFBS has available to distribute comes from the efforts of motivated caring kids who run equipment collections and fundraise on PIFBS' behalf.

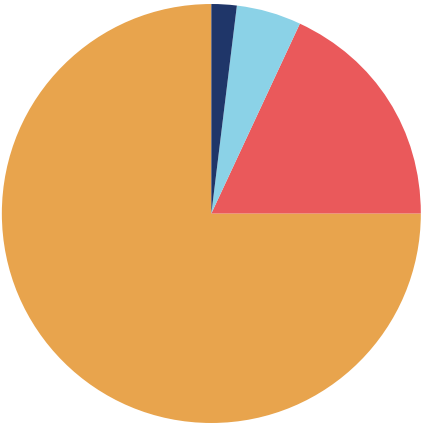

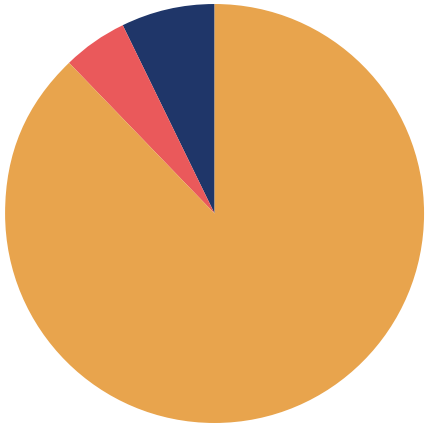

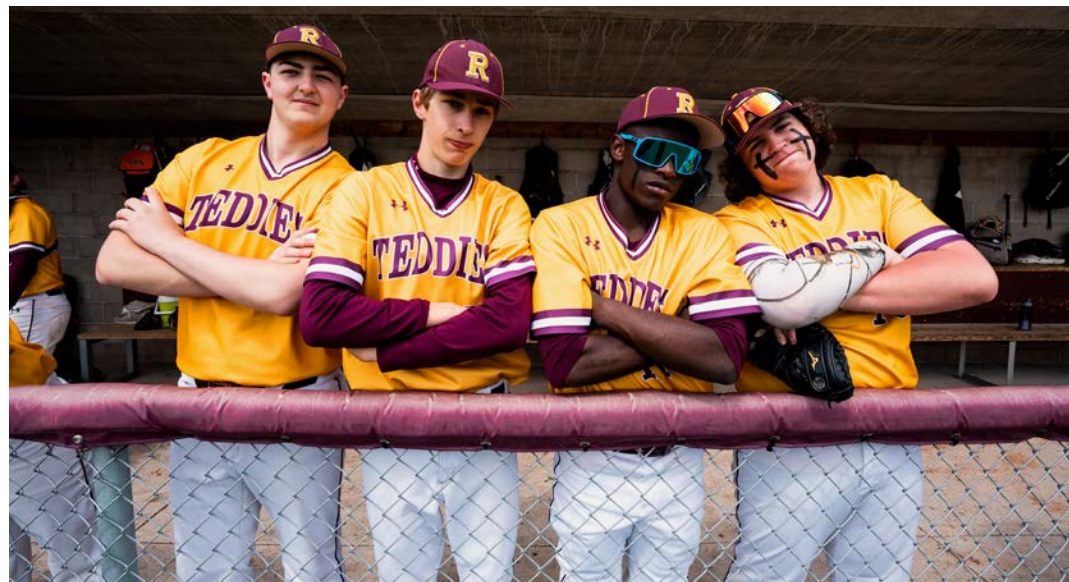

DOMESTIC PROJECTS



SOUTHSIDE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT (CHATTANOOGA, TN)

Ty'Von had the biggest smile when he started playing baseball. After receiving a PIFBS equipment donation, Ty'Von had a bat and glove to use during the season. Even on days when there were no scheduled practices or games, he could be found at the baseball field playing with his friends. Through baseball, Ty'Von improved his skills and boosted his confidence. He learned how to handle the disappointment of failure and the excitement of success, including hitting his first-ever home run!



KA'U LITTLE LEAGUE (NAALEHU, HI)

Charlie tragically lost both his father and grandfather in a fishing accident before the baseball season began. At first, he withdrew from his friends and classmates and felt distant. Charlie decided to join his local team baseball team, hoping that the game could provide him a distraction. Playing baseball with his friends helped him regain his confidence and found comfort in the game. His mother noticed how much happier Charlie was when baseball started and he was playing with his friends.



YES PREP NORTHLINE SOFTBALL (HOUSTON, TX)

"Melany can sometimes be off track and not focused on school. Most of the time, she is a good student and stays out of trouble. However, there were instances last year when she struggled. Once we offered softball, it highlighted Melany as a student-athlete. She flourished and fell in love with the sport. As the Athletic Director at Yes Prep Northline, it was a pleasure to watch Melany grow throughout the year. We saw improvements in her academics, behavior, and attendance. Also, she participated in a sport she had never played before and found out that she loved it and was a natural. Without PIFBS, we would not have been able to expose our students or Melany to the game of softball due to limited funding. As we continue to grow, we will look at different avenues to enhance our softball program for students like Melany at Yes Prep Northline."

INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS



BASEBALL 4 AFRICA | KENYA

Baseball 4 Africa was founded in 2004 with the goal to introduce and grow the game of baseball in Kenya. This year one of their players, Oscar, was about to graduate from school in Kenya. He began playing baseball at age 8 years old. At 17 he led his U18 team to the National Championship and was named MVP for a tournament he participated in.

Through equipment grants from PIFBS, baseball has been able to expand throughout Kenya. Baseball teams now stretch over a 200-mile radius in Kenya, giving an opportunity for kids to learn and play the game.



DEL CARMEN FOUNDATION | VENEZUELA

Prior to his team receiving the donation from Pitch In for Baseball & Softball, Mauricio played the position of catcher, often without a proper glove, padding, helmet, and other protection. His team would rent whatever equipment was available, which would often not provide the appropriate amount of protection. Mauricio's commitment to his team and love for playing baseball meant that he needed to take three different buses over 45 minutes just to arrive to the playing field, despite not having the proper equipment.

The donation from Pitch In for Baseball & Softball has provided his team with the appropriate protection and playing equipment so Mauricio can learn to play catcher with confidence. His continued ability to participate with his team allows for him to focus on the team, the sport, and to help his development and growth into a young adult.

TARGETED PROGRAMS



MINNESOTA TWINS

Launched in 2014, our partnership with the Minnesota Twins supports thousands of kids play ball in the greater Minneapolis and St. Paul area each year through the School-Based Program, Glove Program, and Twins' Community Fund Equipment initiative. In 2023 alone, the Twins equipped 40 high school baseball and softball teams, distributed over 70 equipment kits for 12u teams, and provided 2,600 gloves to kids in the Twins RBI program. In the School-Based Program, an average of 50% of their players improved both grades and attendance during the season, which demonstrates the impact of the game on student success and youth development.



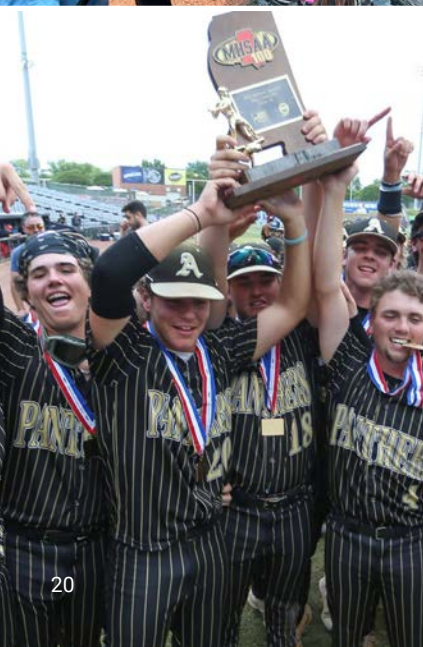
SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS

Pitch In For Baseball & Softball partnered with the San Francisco Giants program for the third consecutive year in 2023 to support equipment needs for nearly 100 Jr. Giants' locations and a School-Based program. This project also included a donation of over 50 pre-packed equipment bags to San Francisco Unified School District baseball and softball programs. With these donations of over 30,000 pieces of equipment valued at over \$900,000, around 25,000 kids were impacted by these efforts last year.



KLUTCH SPORTS GROUP – PANAMA BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL FEDERATION

In 2023, PIFBS partnered with Klutch Sports Group (formerly REP1) to distribute over \$1.5 million in equipment to dozens of leagues and thousands of children throughout Panama. This was the largest baseball and softball equipment donation in the history of Panama. PIFBS partners Wilson Sporting Goods, EvoShield, and Under Armour, helped provide these groups with pants, cleats, bats, catcher's gear, and much more. This equipment will be used to grow the game throughout the country, giving thousands of kids the opportunity to play ball.



AMORY HIGH SCHOOL – WILSON SPORTING GOODS

In late March 2023, Amory, Mississippi was struck by a tornado that brought unprecedented damage to the town and nearly destroyed the local high school. Additionally, the baseball field was destroyed along with all of their equipment. This devastation, however, was not enough to stop the Amory High School baseball team from competing last season. PIFBS and Wilson Sporting Goods joined forces, donating over \$5,000 in equipment so they could continue their season and get their kids back out on the diamond. Against all odds, the team went on to win the state championship! The resiliency of this group is an example of the power baseball and softball have to bring communities together to momentarily escape the hardships they are facing.



MLB/MLBPA YOUTH DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION (YDF)

The Youth Development Foundation (YDF) is a joint venture between MLB and the Players Association to help support the growth of youth baseball and softball programs. This past year YDF and Pitch In For Baseball & Softball entered a fourth year of formal partnership to support the equipment needs for under-resourced communities across the United States. In 2023, this unique collaboration helped 13 groups. Over \$135,000 worth of equipment was donated to various schools, youth groups, and other programs from Pennsylvania all the way to New Mexico.



LOS ANGELES DODGERS

When the Los Angeles Dodgers launched Dodgers RBI (now Dodgers Dream Team) in 2015, they made an ambitious goal to reach 10,000 kids within five years. After reaching that goal, they expanded, aiming to serve 25,000 children by 2030. After slowing efforts for a short period due to the Pandemic, the Dodgers Foundation program came back stronger than ever in 2023, resuming the pre-pandemic growth trajectory. In 2023, the Dodgers and PIFBS partnered to equip over 500 teams in the greater Los Angeles area.



NEW YORK METS

2023 marked the sixth year of partnership between The Amazin' Mets Foundation and Pitch In For Baseball & Softball. The Mets continue to support youth baseball, softball, and tee-ball leagues within each of the six locations their club has a presence, including Port St. Lucie (Florida) Syracuse (NY), Queens (NY), Brooklyn (NY), and Boca Chica (Dominican Republic). This year, the Mets also added donations in Puerto Rico, targeting specifically the hometowns of their star players, Edwin Diaz and Francisco Lindor. In total, over 250 baseball, softball, and tee-ball equipment kits were distributed in the communities that are most meaningful to the New York Mets organization.



MAJOR LEAGUE BASEBALL RBI

Major League Baseball's Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities (RBI) program focuses on increasing baseball and softball participation in the urban communities across the country. Pitch In For Baseball & Softball have been providing support to these efforts since our earliest years, getting much needed gear to these groups. In 2023, PIFBS helped MLB support more than 2,700 kids with the equipment needed to play ball. One of the largest projects of 2023 involved the newly formed Cardinals RBI in St. Louis. Starting the program without equipment, MLB and PIFBS worked to supply the group with the needed gear to hold their first season! In total, over \$125,000 worth of equipment was distributed to RBI programs across the country.

PRO PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS



JOSÉ RAMÍREZ

Earlier this year, PIFBS proudly partnered with the Cleveland Guardians and José Ramírez to host a “Guardians Around the Horn” Baseball clinic in the Dominican Republic in Jose Ramirez’s hometown of Baní. This clinic provided both valuable baseball lessons and equipment to 200 kids. With support from Wilson Sporting Goods, over \$40,000 worth of equipment was donated to help continue to grow the game in the Dominican Republic!



LUCAS GILBREATH

In a multi-partner project that included PIFBS, Wilson Sporting Goods, MLB Players Trust, and non-profit A Precious Child, Colorado Rockies P Lucas Gilbreath hosted a baseball clinic in Denver, CO. More than 100 kids participated in this clinic to learn new skills and build self-confidence! PIFBS donated over \$15,000 in equipment to help expand the game of baseball.



ALESHIA OCASIO

This year featured the first ever AO8 Clinic & Equipment donation partnership with Aleshia Ocasio & Major League Baseball. Generously hosted by Jackie Robinson Training Complex, this clinic supported 100 girls around Vero Beach, FL to learn from professional softball player Aleshia Ocasio! In partnership with Wilson Sporting Goods, PIFBS donated nearly \$20,000 in equipment. This one-day clinic supported 100 girls with the gear needed to play ball and hopefully left feeling confident, energized & empowered.



ELOY JIMÉNEZ

PIFBS partnered with Eloy and Rep 1 (now known as Klutch Sports) to distribute equipment to children who now play baseball on his home field in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic. In 2023, Klutch Sports and PIFBS began working together to deliver equipment directly to player's hometowns. Eloy also generously donated items that were used to raise money for PIFBS' 3rd Annual Online Auction.



EDWIN DIAZ

In partnership with the Amazin' Mets Foundation and their Futuras Estrellas program, PIFBS traveled to Puerto Rico to donate brand new equipment to 50 baseball and softball teams. Equipment was distributed in Guanica, Naguabo, and Caguas, spanning 250 miles and impacting nearly 800 children in one day!

Naguabo is the hometown of New York Mets closer, Edwin Díaz, who spent the day distributing equipment to kids on the same field Díaz grew up playing on as a child.

MVP AWARDS

Starting in 2021, PIFBS launched an annual award program to recognize the amazing donors, grantees, partners, and ambassadors, that played an integral part in helping kids remain on the field. These awards highlight the exemplary work they have done to help over 207,000 kids play ball in 2023.



ROOKIE OF THE YEAR AWARD

All-Star Sports Academy

This award recognizes a first-time donor, partner, organization, or ambassador who made a significant contribution to PIFBS. This could be recognizing a generous equipment donation, fundraiser or monetary gift, or awareness-building efforts.

All-Star Sports Academy (ASSA) is the premier baseball and softball development organization with over 20 years of experience and six training centers across PA and NJ. In 2023, PIFBS launched a partnership with ASSA to raise funds, collect equipment, and build awareness to help kids access the game.



ORGANIZATIONAL MVP AWARD

MLB Players Trust

This award recognizes an organization that made a significant contribution to PIFBS. This could be recognizing a generous equipment donation, a fundraiser or a monetary gift, or awareness-building efforts.

The Players Trust joined PIFBS as a new partner in 2023. The MLB Players Trust amplifies the positive impact MLB Players make in the lifelong well-being of others to include providing next generation youth and young leaders with the tools and resources to learn and grow through the sport they love. Together, PIFBS and the Players Trust were involved in multiple projects in 2023 to help kids gain access to the game.



EQUIPMENT DONOR MVP AWARD

Little League

This award recognizes an organization that led efforts in a significant equipment donation to PIFBS.

Little League was the very first partnership in Pitch In For Baseball & Softball history. After nearly 20 years, Little League continues to be one of PIFBS' strongest supporters. In 2023, Little League donated over 4,000 pieces of equipment including hundreds of helmets, balls, and training aids which helps thousands of kids. Little League also conducts outreach campaigns to encourage equipment donations from their leagues.



EQUIPMENT MVP AWARD

PIFBS Club at Mamaroneck High School

This award recognizes a donor or ambassador who led efforts in a significant equipment donation to PIFBS.

This year's recipient is the student-led PIFBS Club at Mamaroneck High School. This group organized over 50 high school volunteers to donate three pallets worth of equipment! This group returned later in the year to volunteer their time to sort through thousands of pieces of donated equipment.



FUNDRAISING MVP AWARD

Zander S.

This award recognizes a donor or ambassador who led a fundraising campaign to support PIFBS' mission.

Zander S. (Sherman Oaks, CA) was motivated to complete his Mitzvah project with PIFBS "I took a look at all of my baseball equipment, and I was thinking about how expensive it was. I realized that I am lucky and that many kids aren't as lucky as me." His efforts led to him raising nearly \$2,000!



TEAM MVP AWARD

Cleveland Guardians

This award recognizes a Major League Baseball team that has contributed to PIFBS in a significant way such as by providing significant partnership programming, providing awareness-building opportunities, or any other significant contributions.

PIFBS and the Guardians began working together in 2022 to support youth baseball and softball through the City of Cleveland recreation programs. In January 2023, the Guardians hosted a "Guardians Around the Horn" Baseball clinic in the Dominican Republic in Jose Ramirez's hometown of Bani. With a generous donation from Wilson Sporting Goods, PIFBS donated nearly \$40,000 in equipment benefiting more than 200 children. Additionally, the Guardians also generously hosted a suite fundraiser for PIFBS.

EQUIPMENT GRANTEE MVP AWARD

Krushers Fastpitch

This award recognizes a program that received a PIFBS equipment grant. This program provided an impact report that exemplifies the mission of PIFBS and the differences that baseball/softball can bring to a child.

Jessica, age 14, found her confidence through the Pitch In For Baseball & Softball equipment donation that included Warstic bats. The majority of Jessica's early childhood was spent fighting for her safety and protecting her siblings. Due to a tumultuous situation and unfortunate events, Jessica was separated from her siblings, handed over to the system, and lost contact with her family.

Jessica's kind heart and resiliency have carried her through the past eight (8) years, but softball has instilled a sense of confidence and pride in herself. She was gifted one of the Warstic bats which holds near and dear to her heart. Softball has given Jessica something to look forward to and feel proud of, and helped increase her drive and passion for the game and life.



BASEBALL AMBASSADOR MVP AWARD

This award recognizes a donor or ambassador within the softball world who has made a significant contribution to PIFBS. This could be an equipment donation, monetary donation, or an awareness-building initiative. This year's winner is Athletes Unlimited!

Athletes Unlimited Pro Softball is a women's professional softball league that changes the game into can't-miss-a-thing, action-packed moments you've never seen before. Athletes select a charity of their choice to support, as each win they earn leads to a donation to their respective charity. Professional softball player, Aleshia Ocasio, selected PIFBS as her charity of choice, which raised over \$4,800! During their games, Athletes Unlimited Pro Softball also helped to build awareness of PIFBS during their games.

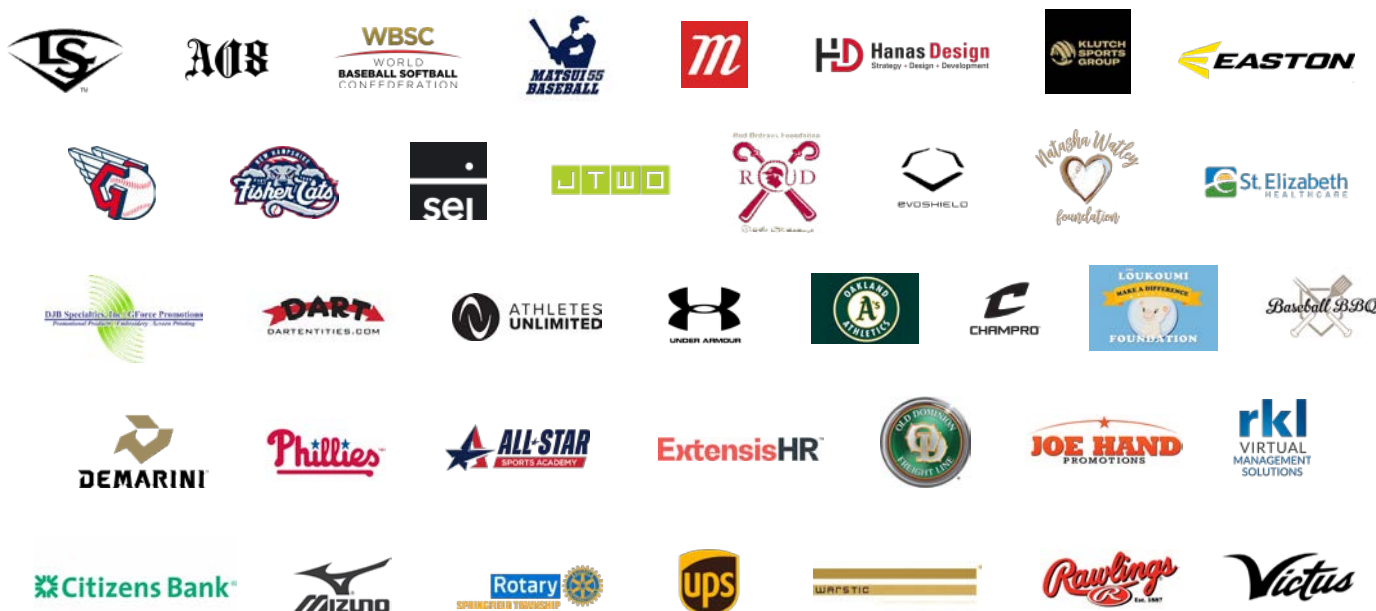

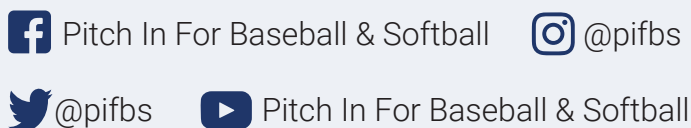
